





1 About Easy PDF Page Cut

Do you have ever gotten such a PDF document whose pages consist of two unrelated parts? Usually we might need to break those PDF pages, and this is a really laboursome job. Now Easy PDF Page Cut provides you best solution to easily cut those pages as you want. Easy PDF Page Cut allows you to edit rule with visual cut marks editor to cut PDF pages, and it enables to batch process at amazing speed.

Easy PDF Page Cut is characterized by its user-friendly interface and simple operation, which facilitate your to edit rule to cut page, even you didn't operate analogous software before. With Easy PDF Page Cut, you can easily batch process a number of PDF files at the same time with great efficiency.

2 Functions and Features

- Enable to cut page vertically/horizontally in half with one click.
- Supports work with command line to break PDF page automatically.
- Add grid, horizontal or vertical lines to define cut rule.
- Allows to adjust split lines manually as per need.
- Supports apply cut operation on all pages or odd/even pages only.
- Batch executes cutting operation on amounts of PDF files with the same rule.
- Export & import cut rules for re-usage.
- Directly drag and drop to add PDF file for page cutting.
- Visual cut marks editor enables to customize rules for splitting PDF page.
- Software compatible with Windows 98/2000/ME/XP/2003/Vista/7.
- Intuitive interface and simple operation.
- Affordable, free trial and upgrade.



Easy PDF Page Cut does NOT require Adobe Acrobat, and produces documents compatible with Adobe Acrobat Reader Version 5 and above.




3 Using Easy PDF Page Cut

Under Windows Operation System, Easy PDF Page Cut can be started either via the desktop shortcut, or directly from Windows explorer.

When you start the program, if you haven't registered our product, you will be informed to purchase the full version.

Then you will be presented with the primary screen.



Add documents

Clicking the **Open** icon , or selecting **File** then choosing **Open** will open the standard file browse and select window. From that window you can navigate to the folder and find the PDF you want to open. Opened PDF pages thumbnail are displayed in the Easy PDF Page Cut left window (PDF thumbnail): as seen in the example below. You can view any of the pages in the window by 'clicking' them. That will display in right PDF pages preview window.



Add Pages Cut Mask

✧ Add split (cut) lines

Add new grid, vertical or horizontal splitters with  and  or  button. New splitters will appear in the top and left part of working area;

✧ Delete split (cut) line

Click  icon to delete selected splitter.

✧ Adjust split (cut) lines position

Click left mouse button on a splitter, the selected splitter will be marked color to red, then you can change position of splitters (push left mouse button on the selected splitter and pull it in required direction). You

also press Ctrl + Up or Ctrl + Down to shift the selected splitters position, you can click undo



icon or redo



icon to rollback the operation.


✧ Set cut page order

You can adjust the cut slice order for every PDF original page, select the order mode: horizontal, vertical, first-last, last-first.

Horizontal - cut the pages down before drawing them across the sheet of page, For example, in 4 up, the page ordering would be:



Vertical - cut the pages across before drawing them down the sheet of page. For example, in 4 up mode, the page ordering would be:





First-last - cut the pages across before drawing them down the sheet of page. Only apply for 2 up mode, the page ordering would be:



Last- First - cut the pages across before drawing them down the sheet of page. Only apply for 2 up mode, the page ordering would be:



✦ **Apply current split(cut) lines settings to all other pages**

After finished adjusting current split lines position, you can click **apply** icon to apply the current settings to all other pages

Cut and Save as

After finished the adding pages cut masks, you can cut and save the file using the **Save** icon  , Easy PDF Page Cut automatically cut pages into each slice based on cut marks (vertical or horizontal split lines) and then merges each PDF page slice into the new PDF for you.



Command line

PDF Page Cut Command line (PPCCMD.exe) can be used as a Windows console utility that silent crop PDF pages .

Usage:

```
PPCCMD.exe <Source PDF> <Destination PDF> <Lines>
```

Parameters:

<Source PDF> Source PDF file.

<Output PDF> Specifies the name for the output file.

<Lines> Specifies horizontal cut lines and vertical cut

Lines position; set cut page order The <Lines> can be like this:

```
-L<pages>=(Horizaontal lines),(Vertical lines):<Page Order>
```

<Lines> Parameter:

<pages>: means all pages 1-10,20,23 : means from page 1 to
page 10 and so on...

(Horizaontal lines),(Vertical lines) : should looks

like: (10,20,30),(50) which means pages will be cut based on:

three horizaontal lines (position:10%,20% ,30%) and one

vertical line (in the middle of the page)

<Page Order>: should be:F or L or H or V; F: First-Last,

L:Last-First, H: Horizontal V: Vertical.

Example: "-L*=(),(50):F": meams all page in the source
file will be cut into half based on a vertical
line and the output file"s page order will
be "First-Last"

Return code:

0: Success

2: Input PDF not found

3: The parameters are invalid.

4: Load PDF error

5: Password error

6: Nonsupport security

7: Failed to save the ouput file

Example:

```
PPCCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "-L*=(),(50):F"
```

```
PPCCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "-L*=(50),():L"
```

```
PPCCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "-L1-10,33=(10,20)
```



```
,(20,60,80):H"  
PPCCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "-L*=(),(50):V" "  
-L9-15,32=(50),():V"
```
